



<u>Literacy</u>	text? Monday = Explain how this is our last week in Reception. How does that make you feel? What have you enjoyed doing in Reception? What will you work harder on next year? Work through Goodbye Reception writing frame together. Ask your child the Questions & get them to fill in each box, using their Phonics & trying to write independently. Tuesday = Explain how Miss Wellburn (Yr 1) and Miss Kennedy (Yr ½) want to learn more about you. We're going to write a letter to our new teachers. Explain how to lay out a letter e.g. with address & using to/dear and from at the end. Explain how you need to tell your teacher about yourself e.g. favourite foods, favourite activities as well as things you want to ask next year. Children to write out letters. Wednesday = Explain how it's nearly Summer. We're not coming to school for 5 weeks. What are you going to do over the summer? Are you doing anything special? What would you like to do? Snakes and Ladders



You will need...

- The Snakes and Ladders Board Game board
- A dice
- A counter per player

How to play...

- Players take it in turns to roll the dice. The player with the highest number goes first, the person with the second highest goes second and so on.
- 2 The player moves the counter the number of spaces shown on the dice.
- 3. If a player lands on a snake's head, the player's counter slides down to the square at the snake's tail.
- 4. If a player lands on the bottom of a ladder, the player's counter climbs up to the square at the top of the ladder.
- 5. The first player to reach 25 is the winner.
