Creative Challenge 1 Chalk Art Mosaic – Can you create a piece of art outside? You might want a grown up to help. 1) Mark out your design using masking tape and colour in the space with chalk. 2) Use water and a paint brush to smooth over the chalk. 3) Leave you chalk art to dry before removing the tape. Take a picture of your object and then do an observational drawing and colour it in. You might want to do a drawing, a painting, a collage, make your artwork 3D by using cardboard or do some loose part art using natural materials or objects from around the house.

Can you guess what the sounds are?	<u>Musical Challenge 2</u> Draw Dance to Music -Can you draw dance to music? Using crayons, pencils, felt tips or paintbrushes, listen to a piece of music of your choice and move your hand to the music. Explore with different types of music	<u>Garden Challenge 2</u> Balance a toy – Can you keep a small toy still on your body? Can you balance on different parts of your body and still keep the toy still? How long can you balance it for? Can you pass the toy to a member of your family without using your hands?
