Creative Challenge 1

Grown-up supervision required!

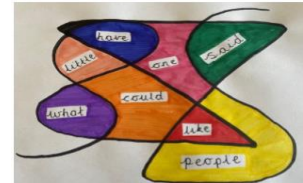
Can you have a go at creating some beautiful Japanese Hapa Zome prints? This is a way of printing with leaves and flowers. You'll need to collect some colourful petals and leaves first. Once you have done that you'll need a piece of material or a piece of paper. Now you need to arrange the petals and leaves on top of your material/paper. For the next bit your grown-up will need to help you to squash down the petals and leaves onto your material or paper (a hammer works best for this, but anything heavy will do). This should leave you with some beautiful prints. You may want to experiment with printing on different materials and see which works the best.



Creative Challenge 2

Creative - Tricky word Art

Take your pen or pencil for a walk, remembering not to take it off the paper. Fill each section with a tricky word or letter sound and colour in. You could try and put the tricky words into some silly sentences.



STEM Challenge 1

STEM -Butterfly feeder

What you'll need:

- 1 paper plate
 - String
 - Some over-ripe, rotten, mushy fruit.
1. Make four holes around the rim of your plate. Make sure they're equally spaced or your feeder will be lopsided!
 2. Thread a piece of string through each hole and tie them off. Now tie the four ends together above the plate.
 3. Place pieces of mushy fruit like bananas and peaches onto the plate.
 4. Hang it near some flowers and wait for butterflies to flutter by.

STEM Challenge 2

STEM -Scavenger Hunt

Go on a scavenger hunt around your house/garden.

- Find something that you can turn.
- Find something that is bumpy.
- Find something that is metal.
- Find something you put together.
- Find 3 things that are round.
- Find something that you twist.
- Find something shiny.
- Find something that you can roll.
- Find a tube.
- Find 3 things that are squishy.
- Find something that can bounce.

Garden Challenge

Can you make an obstacle course in your garden or on your pavement?

You might want to use a 'Hopscotch' style with spaces to hop, jump, spin, follow a line, clap, do a dance, do an exercise, pull a funny face, sing ... have fun with it.



Cooking Challenge

Tortilla pizza –

Make sure this is done with a grown up. Place

a tortilla on a baking tray and drizzle with olive oil. Add tomato puree and cheese to your tortilla. Make a picture or pattern using different ingredient which you like. Place in the oven until the cheese has melted. Enjoy your pizza!
