LKS2 Trip—Formby Beach



On Monday 24th June, Lower Key Stage 2 travelled to the National Trust at Formby beach. Here we undertook fieldwork for both science and geography. After travelling, we completed 3 activities and built on the knowledge we had already gained in class.

We investigated the strand line where we realised that nothing lives on the beach only in the sea or under the sand as it is always changing. We found jellyfish, hermit crabs, a deceased fish and exoskeletons from crabs. We climbed sand dunes and recognised the different dunes and what can live on there. Finally, we spotted signs of coastal erosion and how the landscape has changed over the years. It was a hot, humid day but the behaviour of the three classes represented our school fantastically.
