## Bottle Top Collection



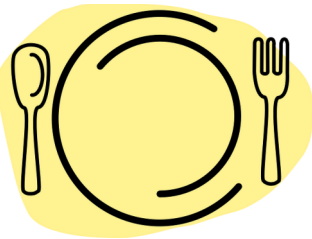
We are collecting plastic bottle tops of all different sizes and colours for an art project. Please save and send any plastic bottle tops with you child into school throughout this half term. Thank you.
