Children in Need



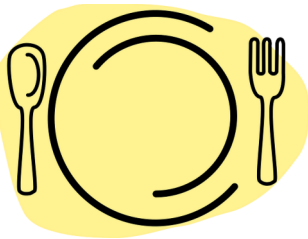
