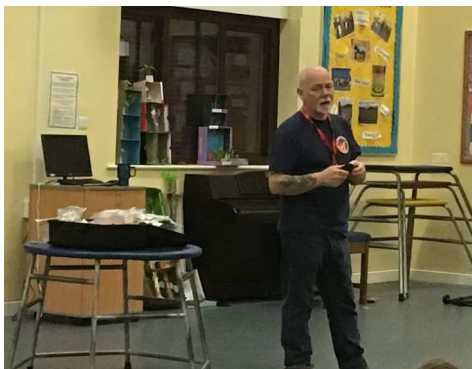

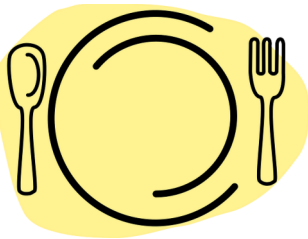
It was a fantastic Animal Magic Party!!!
