

Literacy

In Summer 1 the children will be continuing to focus on revisiting and applying their Phase 3 Phonics using Phonics Bug. We will be following the same routine of a new sound from Monday – Thursday with Friday being our language lesson, focusing on tricky words.

Program.

1. Air, ear, igh, ure
2. Oa, ee, ai, oo (short), oo (long)

Irregular Words to be taught and revisited Spring 2 :

Me, be, he, by, my, she, they, we, are, you, all, was, give, live

In Literacy, we will be focusing on these new texts: Oliver's Fruit Salad, Eat Your Greens Goldilocks, Find Your Happy, Little Red Riding Hood, Ruby's Worry's, Elmer Super Daisy, Super Elliot

Maths

In Robin Class, we follow the White Rose Maths scheme of learning. This is also supported by our use of the NCETM curriculum for further embedding.

In Summer 1, we will be focusing on the following key areas of learning.

- To 20 and Beyond.
- Counting to 20 and writing numbers to 20.
- Focusing on one more and one less
- Looking at how many.
- Manipulate, compose and decompose looking at 2D shapes.

PSED

In this topic we will be celebrating our families:

- Discussing who is important to us.
- Explaining why we need our family.
- How does our family look after us?
- Showing kindness towards others.

Healthy Happy Me

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will be creating their own flags and sporting uniforms using recycled materials and working collaboratively. We will be discussing our creations, evaluating and planning carefully.

The children will be exploring different textures and the strength of different materials. The children will be able to use colour mixing to create the effect of wood and other materials.

Physical Development

In this unit children will develop their ball skills through the topic of 'Healthy Happy Me'. Children will develop fundamental ball skills such as rolling and receiving a ball, throwing to a target, bouncing and catching, dribbling with feet and kicking a ball.

Children will focus on accuracy and sharing equipment with each other. We will be continuing with Yoga to develop their core strength.

Children will be able to develop their fine and gross motor skills through a range of game play using a variety of equipment. Children will be given opportunities to work independently and with a partner.

Communication and Language

We aim to develop communication and language through all of the learning which takes place in Robin Class. By utilising continuous provision areas such as Role Play and Small World.

We also aim to develop communication and language skills through more focused activities such as literacy and PSED. Some of the ways in which we practice this is by:

- We will be encouraging the children with role play, getting into character and retelling familiar stories.
- We will be developing our use of discussion tactics using Voice 21.
- We will be using love of language questioning during reading sessions.
- We will be introducing 'drawing club' where we will expand the children's vocabulary and develop their imaginations.

We will be creating new 'moments' for writing and conversations in our 'message centre'. We will be using the communication tools of instigate, build and challenge when holding whole class discussions.

Children in Robin will be using presentational talk to discuss and share their hobbies considering the pace of their voice, tone and body language.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

During this topic the children will be looking at how we can keep Healthy and Happy. We will be exploring the importance of a balanced diet and exercise. The children will be exploring different hobbies as well as the importance of being outside and looking after nature,

We will be looking at famous athletes, focusing on where they live, what they do and how they look after themselves.
