CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

This term, pupils will be writing a biography and narrative, drawing inspiration from our class author Frank Cottrell-Boyce to develop rich storytelling skills while also learning how to structure and write effective biographies.

In maths, we are continuing our work on decimals—reading, writing, comparing and using them in real-life problem solving—alongside developing understanding of perimeter, area and statistics through interpreting data, drawing graphs and solving geometry challenges.

Our wider curriculum includes learning about the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings in History, exploring Earth and Space in Science, taking part in musical rehearsals and the Snappy Opera project, developing teamwork and invasion-game skills in PE, learning coding and debugging using Micro:bit in Computing, studying key Christian beliefs in RE, preparing Anglo-Saxon-inspired dishes in DT, and reflecting on health, choices and wellbeing in PSHE as part of our Healthy Me unit.
