<p>Phonics – ‘ou’ sound. What ways can you make it (ou, ow). Watch the video the link is below. Can you have a go at the ‘ou’ worksheet? Are there anymore ‘ou’ or ‘ow’ words you can think of?</p>	<p>Phonics – ‘aw’ sound. Watch the Aplhablocks video. Can you practise writing the sound? Ask a grown up to help you write some ‘aw’ words on post-it notes and hide them round the house and then go on a hunt collecting them.</p>	<p>Phonics – ‘th’ sound. Have a go at making the sound. Then have a go at writing it. Can you get an adult to write some words with the ‘th’ sound for you to read? Play the ‘th’ and ‘f’ pairs game by matching them up.</p>	<p>Phonics – ‘sh’ sound. Watch the ‘sh’ phonics video. Stop and get the children to read each word. Have a go at the real and alien sheet.</p>	<p>Phonics – ‘ch’ sound. Watch the ‘ch’ video. Stop and get the children to read each word. Have a go at the ‘sh’, ‘ch’, ‘th’, and ‘ng’ sheet.</p>
<p>English – Read the story ‘Sidney the Spider’. Can you then fill in the ‘post-it sheet’?</p>	<p>English – Re-read the story can you complete the sheet ‘Who said what?’ You can draw or write the characters names.</p>	<p>English – Can you retell someone in your house the story of ‘Sidney Spider’? Then have a go at the quiz sheet.</p>	<p>English – Mrs Brown liked to sing Incy Wincy Spider. Can you listen to the song and have a go at making your own actions? Could you then write out the song drawing pictures to match each line?</p>	<p>English – Re-read the story. Can you have a look at the letter activity sheet and add the capital letters and full stops. Could you then have a go at writing your own in your best handwriting?</p>
<p>Maths – Can you have a go at writing numbers to 20? Make sure they are formed correctly. Have a go at using the natural resources to create your own one more and one less grid. Use the image below to help you.</p>	<p>Maths – Use Splat number grid, there is a link to it below. Splat numbers and read one more and one less than that number. Have a go at the one more and one less dice activity.</p>	<p>Maths – Can you get an adult to write the numbers 0-20 on small bits of paper? Then you can put them in the correct order. Using Lego bricks can you build towers with more and less bricks using the language more than and less than.</p>	<p>Maths – Talk about the maths signs < > and =. Remember Charlie the crocodile eats the biggest number. Complete the greater than and less than picture sheet. Could you challenge yourself to make your own?</p>	<p>Maths – Can you tell a grown up a number that is greater than 20? Can you tell them a number that is less than 20? Have a go at the greater than and less than number sheet and pick your challenge.</p>
<p>PE – Can you have a go at creating some Yoga moves to teach to someone in your household? Google some inspiration for ideas. Cosmic kids and Happy Tent Tales are good starting points.</p>	<p>Science – Watch the BBC Bitesize video, then have a go at the alien material sheet.</p>	<p>Art – Watch the BBC Bitesize collage clip. Can you have a go at creating your own collage spider. Make it as colourful as you like! I will put a template to help you.</p>	<p>Computing – Can you have a go at the BBC Bitesize clip below? You might need help from an adult but have a go at opening a ‘word’ document and writing a letter to a friend.</p>	<p>Music – Can you watch the clip below looking at instruments made of rubbish? Can you have a go at making your own instrument out of recycled items? It could be a shaker, drum or anything else you could think of.</p>
<p>Reading – Can you share your favourite book with an adult?</p>	<p>Maths – Have a go on Numbots.</p>	<p>Relaxation – Can you spend time doing something that you enjoy?</p>	<p>Wellbeing – Can you have a go at learning a new skill or perhaps teaching someone an existing skill you have? (it could be tying shoe laces, painting, keeping fit, drawing, baking, building)</p>	<p>Challenge – Can you build something out of Lego, Knex, bricks or anything else you have? Take a photograph of what you have create.</p>

Reading – Can you draw your favourite character from a story and explain why you have chosen them?
