<p>Phonics - 'ar' sound. Say the sound and then have a go at writing it. Can you read a story together, were there any 'ar' words in that story? Complete the 'ar' piggy bank sheet.</p>	<p>Phonics - 'or' sound. Watch the Gerladine video for the 'or' sound. Can you write down the words Geraldine finds? Have a go at the real or alien 'or' sheet.</p>	<p>Phonics - 'oa' sound. Think about how many ways you can make to 'oa' sound (oa, ow, o_e) Can you think of some words with the different 'oa' sounds? Can you play hangman outside using chalk using some of these words?</p>	<p>Phonics - 'y' (making the 'ee' sound. Talk about the 'y' coming at the end of words. Get a grown up to write the words funny, bunny, happy, story, pony. Can you read these words? Can you create a seaside picture? In the picture can you hide 'y' words and challenge someone to find them.</p>	<p>Phonics - 'oo' sound. Watch the Alphablocks video on the 'oo' sound. Can you find anything in your house with this sound in? Once you have found some items draw them and label using correct spelling choices.</p>
<p>English - Re-read the story 'Sidney the Spider'. Talk to someone about what you know about spiders. Read the spider fact sheet. Can you find out any of you own spider facts?</p>	<p>English - Talk about all the facts you now know about spiders. Can you investigate where they might live? Go on a mini beast hunt and then complete the mini beast hunt sheet.</p>	<p>English - Talk about the differences between fiction and non-fiction texts. Think about what you might want to put in your fact file about spiders. Can you create a spider diagram with ideas of things you will want to include?</p>	<p>English - Look at your spider diagram from yesterday to take note of the things you wanted to include on your fact file. Can you add anything? Have a go at completing the fact file template sheet.</p>	<p>English - Can you read your fact file to a grown up? Then have a go at making three changes. Perhaps you could add an adjective, check your spellings, reword or neaten your handwriting.</p>
<p>Maths - Talk to an adult about what you know about a half. Look at the sign and write it yourself $\frac{1}{2}$. Can you have a go at drawing or painting some 2D shapes and colouring half of them in?</p>	<p>Maths - Now you know what a half looks like talk to an adult about a quarter. Again have a go at writing it $\frac{1}{4}$. Can you make cut out some 2D shapes and fold them into halves and quarters? You can use the shape sheet to help you.</p>	<p>Maths - Remind yourself what half and a quarter looks like. Can you have a go at the shape colouring sheet?</p>	<p>Maths - Now we know what half of a shape looks like can we have a go at half and quarter of a number. Using bricks or natural resources find $\frac{1}{2}$ and a $\frac{1}{4}$ of numbers up to 20.</p>	<p>Maths - Can you complete the half and quarter sheet?</p>
<p>PE - Can you find different ways to jump? Perhaps you could use chalk and create some targets for you to jump on. Try landing with 2 legs, then one leg and using your arms. How many jumps can you do in 1 minute?</p>	<p>Science - Watch the BBC Bitesize clip on the lifecycle of a plant. Can you create a diagram to show the life cycle? You can be as creative as you like!</p>	<p>Art - Can you have a go at creating your own piece of art work of a mini beast habitat?</p>	<p>Computing - Follow the link below and download the Smartie the Penguin story. Can you then create a poster showing us what you have learnt? You could even use a computer to do your work on!</p>	<p>Music - Can you download the App 'Garage Band (it is free) and create your own piece of music. If you can't then have a go at using things around your house to create music with.</p>
<p>Reading - Can you share your favourite book with an adult?</p>	<p>Maths - Have a go on Numbots.</p>	<p>Relaxation - Spend some time listening and dancing to music?</p>	<p>Wellbeing - Can you write down 5 things that are great about you? Learn the song and actions for '123 it's good to be me'. I have posted the link below.</p>	<p>Challenge - Can you have a go at creating your own mini beast habitat in the garden?</p>
