PSHE

In this half term, we will be talking about what it is to be a kind friend. We will focus on how we can help and be kind to one another and will discuss what bullying is.

RE

In this half term, we will be focusing on Islam. We will be learning about Shahadah and the five pillars of Islam.

Music

Art

Science

In this topic, children will learn about the basic needs that all humans need to survive. They will study more closely the importance of exercise, a healthy diet and good hygiene as ways to keep us healthy. They will also look at offspring of different animals and how they develop and change into adults as they grow. Finally, children will also look at ways to keep themselves from becoming ill as well as things they can do if they do become ill.

PΕ

In this half term, we will develop the fundamental skills of balancing, running, changing direction, jumping, hopping and skipping.
