PSHE

In this half term, we will be looking at different families. We will discuss how families come in varying forms and will build understanding and acceptance for families of every kind.

RΕ


In this half term, we will be continuing our study of Islam. We will be looking at what life is like as a Muslim and learning more about the Muslim places of worship and sacred text.

Music

In the run up to Christmas, children will be learning and performing their Christmas nativity songs to share with the school and a wider audience. We will be focusing on controlled pitch, singing as part of a large group and creating an overall performance.

DΤ

This half term, children will have the opportunity to create a handmade pouch from material. These will be crafted from fabric and children will learn basic sewing and joining skills.



<u>Science</u>

This half term we will be continuing our study of animals including humans. Children will learn about the basic needs that all humans need to survive. They will study more closely the importance of exercise, a healthy diet and good hygiene as ways to keep us healthy. They will also look at affspring of different animals and how they develop and change into adults as they grow. Finally, children will also look at ways to keep themselves from becoming ill as well as things they can do if they do become ill.

PΕ

In this half term, we will be focusing on fitness. We will be finding ways in which we can conduct cardio exercise and will discuss the impact that this has on our bodies. We will be building on our running, jumping, hopping and skipping skills and will use a variety of equipment to carry out our exercise. Pupils will have the opportunity to work independently. in pairs and small groups.

History

In this topic, children will explore how toys have changed through time. They will explore how technology and industry has altered the way we play. They will be given the opportunity to handle objects from the past and will use their historical enquiry skills to deduce the era which they think they will have come from. Children will explore what it is to be an historian and will begin to develop their historical enquiry skills.

Computing

In this half term, children will be focusing on coding. We will be using Scratch Junior to help us learn how to control digital animations.
