

<p><b>Geography – My Region and the South Aegean, Greece</b></p> <p>In this unit, pupils will discover how the world is represented on maps and globes by being able to identify latitude, longitude, the equator, northern and southern hemispheres, the arctic circle and Antarctic circle. They will discuss the key geographical features of the UK, the Humber region and Greece. The pupils will learn what tectonic plates are and how their movement causes earthquakes and volcanic eruptions in the South Aegean.</p>	<p><b>Languages – French Les Fruits</b></p> <p>In this unit, pupils will learn a selection of the key phonemes to facilitate accurate and authentic pronunciation as part of their language learning experience. During this unit, pupils will learn 10 fruits and be introduced to the simple opinions 'I like' and 'I do not like'. By the end of the unit pupils will have the knowledge and skills to be able to say which fruits they like and do not like.</p>	<p><b>PE –Basketball and Swimming</b></p> <p>In this unit pupils will develop their basketball skills whilst taking part in games and apply the basic principles suitable for attacking and defending. Pupils will be given the opportunity to work on their own and with others, taking turns and sharing ideas.</p> <p>This term the children will also be taking part in swimming and water safety. They will be taught how to swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres using a range of strokes and be able to perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations.</p>
<p><b>Science – Animals Including Humans</b></p> <p>In this unit, the children will describe the basic parts of the digestive system in humans. They will identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions. The children will construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey.</p>	<div data-bbox="1019 678 1220 901" data-label="Image"> </div> <p><b>Merlin Class – Autumn Term 1 Curriculum Overview</b></p>	<p><b>RE – God – Islam</b></p> <p>In this unit pupils will learn how praying at regular intervals helps Muslims in their everyday life. The children will discuss some of the reasons why Muslims pray and why they may choose to pray in a Mosque. The children will explore how commitment can be hard and discuss how it feels to be able to reach a goal.</p>
<p><b>Art – How do artists draw perspective?</b></p> <p>In this drawing unit, children will learn how artists create perspective, how they use line, shape, and value to create a sense of form, and different shading techniques. They will learn from the work of great painters, modern artists, and collagists. They will develop their ability to evaluate their own work, and they will become more confident while creating their own more divergent outcomes.</p>	<p><b>Computing – Multi-media skills</b></p> <p>In this unit, the children will refine their iMovie skills before introducing a green screen to help them create content in iMovie. They will be introduced to loops in GarageBand to help them create music to add to their iMovie. The children will also use pages to be able to present a report and use office 365 to send an email to discuss and include information regarding our geography topic.</p>	<p><b>PSHE – Being me in my world</b></p> <p>In this unit pupils will learn how to be part of a class team and a school citizen. They will be able to identify their rights, responsibilities and democracy through links to the school council. The children will discuss rewards and consequences. They will develop their group decision-making skills and discuss how they can use their voice to identify their rights and responsibilities. They will start to explore what motivates different behaviours.</p>
