

I can't go to school- what do I need to do?

A guide for parents and children



In the event of a school closure, this is your handy guide to remote learning
at Enfield Academy.

All children are expected to engage with lessons on a daily basis.

Learning is not optional during this time.

Day 1 and 2 of school closure:

During the initial 2 days of a school closure, all children are expected to spend time accessing online educational learning platforms e.g. TTRockstars, NumBots, ReadTheory, Lexia, Prodigy Maths or any other websites that your children may have access to. Your child's class teacher will instruct you as to which platforms to access via ClassDojo. You will also receive an updated login card for your child with all of his/her details on it. This will be sent as a private message on ClassDojo, due to GDPR.

Beyond the first 2 days:

A schedule of home learning will be posted to ClassDojo via the class story **and** sent individually by message to all parents. This will contain the details of the daily expectations for your children and contain any links to websites that they may need to access.

Children will be expected to post photographs of their work to their own personal portfolio on ClassDojo at the end of every lesson, where the class teacher can give immediate feedback.

Future schedules of daily learning will always be posted by 9am on a Monday morning.

Daily challenges for phonics (R – Y2) and physical activities (Y3 – Y6) will be posted to the class story by 9am daily.
