This half term, Year 1 will be taking their Phonics Screening Check to see how well they can apply their phonics learning and Year 4 will complete their Multiplication Tables Check to see how quickly they can recall their times tables. Both of these checks highlight the importance of these skills in underpinning children's fluency to enable them to appropriately progress into the next stages of their learning and curriculum. It is a timely reminder to practise reading and times tables for your year group regularly. Good luck to all those taking these checks this half term.

<u>Staffing update-</u> Mrs Lehman in Kingfisher Class has now started her maternity leave and we look forward to announcing her impending arrival! Miss Storkey has now joined us as Kingfisher Class teacher until the end of the summer term.
