

Science

Animals Including Humans

In science, children will learn about animals, including humans, which have offspring which grow into adults. They will find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival. The children will also learn about the importance, for humans, of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food and hygiene.

Geography

My Local Area and Tulum, Mexico

In this unit, children will use atlases and globes to discover about the world, including the seven continents and five oceans, the countries, capital cities and surrounding seas of the UK and the equator and poles. Children will develop fieldwork and map skills creating maps of the school and their local area. Children will learn the geographical human and physical features of Tulum in Mexico and compare them to the geographical features of their own local area.

Music

Pulse, Rhythm and Pitch

In music, children will focus on learning that music is a combination of pulse, rhythm and pitch. They will learn and listen to many different styles of music and begin to recognise different sounds and hear how they create harmony together. They will play instruments together and have fun learning to play in a band or ensemble.

P.E

Fitness

In P.E the children will take part in a range of activities to develop components of fitness. Pupils will begin to explore and develop agility, balance, co-ordination, speed and stamina. Pupils will develop perseverance and show determination to work for longer periods.
