Enfield Academy has plans to increase in capacity to become a 210 place school, with seven classes instead of the present six.

Plans for a £1.2 million building extension (funded by North East Lincolnshire Local Authority) are nearing completion and initial building works (phase one) will start during the summer break this year.

While this is brilliant news for our school, we can only apologise in advance for the disruption that will be caused throughout the coming year – or perhaps longer.

Not only will Enfield be receiving an additional classroom, other upgraded facilities are also being discussed and planned for.

Once the full project has passed planning permission, we will be able to share the finer details with you.
