

PSHE

During this term, we will be learning how to recognise and manage our feelings and emotions. We will talk about uncomfortable feelings and how to deal with these.

We will consider things that we like and don't like and how this differs from other people. We will talk about what makes us special as individuals and how to speak up when something is concerning us. We will discuss change and how to cope with loss.

Music

This term, children will be exploring improvisation in music. They will understand how music can effect our emotions and will explore ways to improvise music both their voices and instruments.

We will consider music in the wider-curriculum and use instruments to enhance our musical skills and knowledge.

RF

In this topic, we will consider how religious groups from around the World display 'thankfulness'. We will consider the similarities and differences and how being thankful is celebrated in different communities and religions.

Weather and Climate

Science

In this term, we will be concluding our work on plants. We will consider what plants need in order to survive. We will conduct an experiment to see how plants survive in different conditions. We will make predictions based upon our knowledge of plants and will record and gather data from our experiment.

Children will also learn about different famous scientists and will conduct independent investigative work.

Computing

In this term, children will be working on their coding skills and using Scratch Junior as the main platform for their learning.



PE

During this term, children will be taking up their Physical Education outdoors. We will be conducting invasion games and working on our team building skills.

We will also resume our Daily Mile practice and will work on developing our overall physical fitness.

Geography

In this topic, children will learn about the differences between weather and climate. They will learn about basic climate zones and conditions. They will learn about weather forecasts and symbols and the instruments that are used to collect and record weather data. Children will conduct their own weather-based fieldwork in the school grounds.
