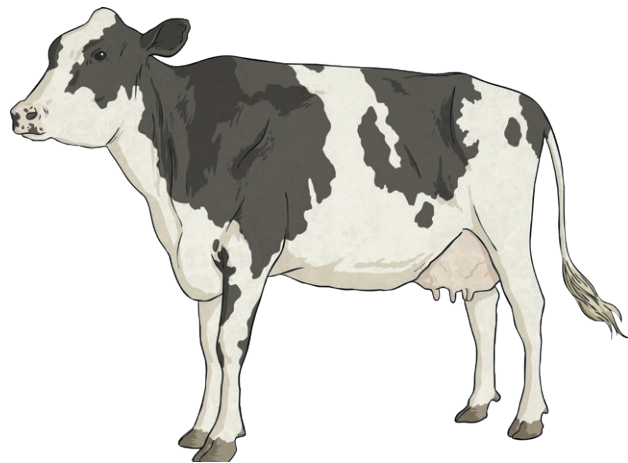
From Farm to Glass: The Story of Milk

process the grass into milk.**

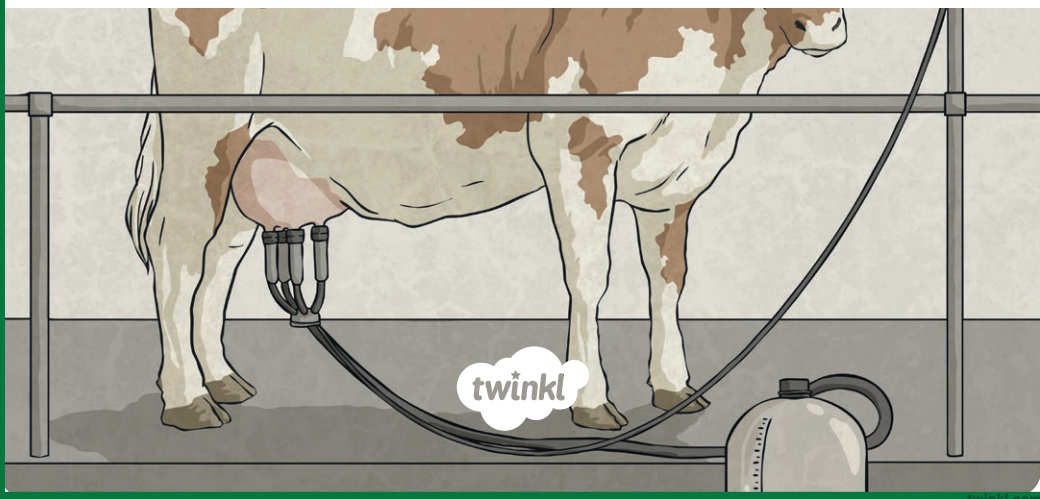

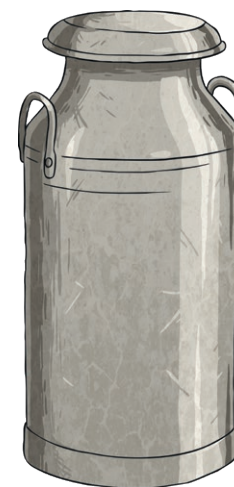
**The cows' udders store the milk

The cows are milked either by hand or by a machine.



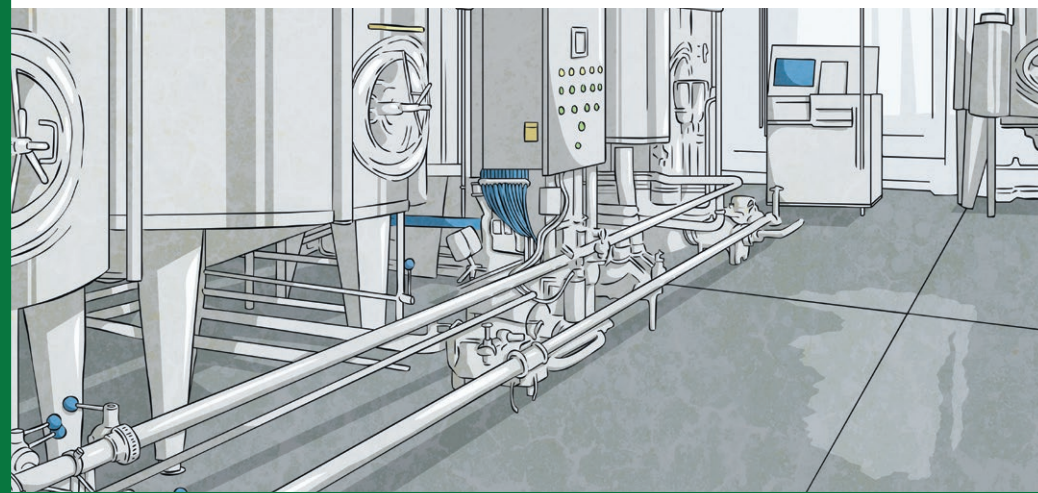
The milk is kept cold and stored.
