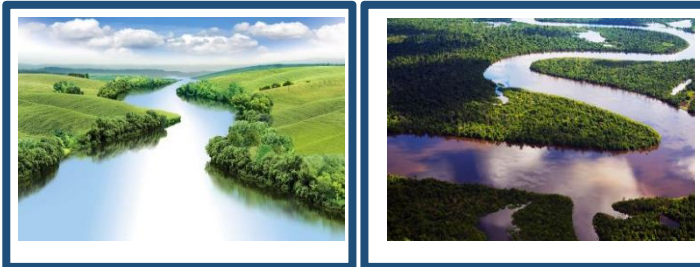
Computing

English

Children learn and recite the poem 'The River'. Add actions and perform the poem to an audience.

Read *The Rhythm of the Rain* by Grahame Baker-Smith as stimulus. Children create their own story about a journey down the river in the form of a diary.
