WE ARE LEARNING ABOUT:

RE:

This term we will be exploring Creation and Covenant: how God made our World and everything in it. We will explore Prophecy and Promise, focusing on the Nativity story. We will look at what makes us unique and individual.

PERSONAL SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT:

This term is all about settling into our new classes, learning the routines and rules and how to share and solve conflicts.
