We are very aware of the current cost of living crisis and we appreciate that everybody's circumstances are different.

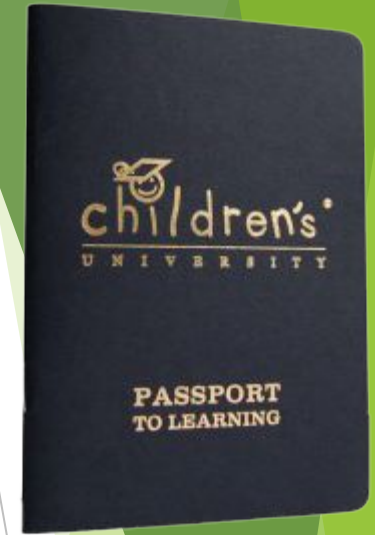
We would still like the children to experience a school trip this year but will limit this to one in the summer term. This trip will link with our history topic, the Romans.

Children's University

Children's University is a charity that works in partnership with schools to develop a love of learning in children. This is achieved by encouraging and celebrating participation in extra-curricular activities in and outside of school.

- ▶ Passports available from the office - £3
- ▶ One credit is awarded for one hour of activity (from clubs that are validated by CU) - with a maximum of ten credits per term per activity
- ▶ Credits from clubs in school are recorded by school (not in passport)
- ▶ Half termly activities are sent out to parents- photos showing evidence of completion of tasks sent to CU and credits are awarded.
- ▶ Graduation takes place in Year 2 and Year 6- Graduation Ceremony at Edge Hill.
- ▶ Credits can be achieved from residentials, Summer Reading Challenges and visiting particular museums.

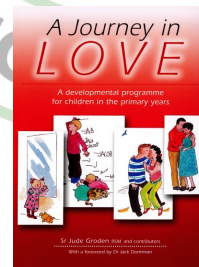
RSHE

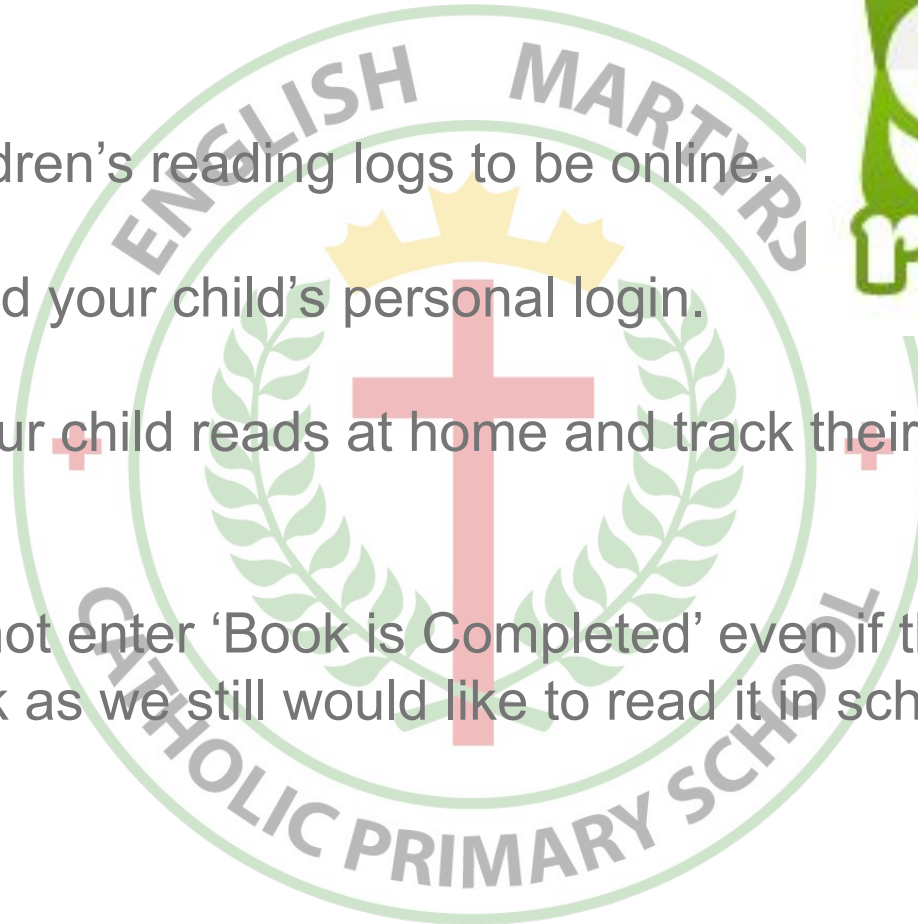
Go Read App

We have moved children's reading logs to be online.

You will have received your child's personal login.

You can log when your child reads at home and track their reading in school.

We ask that you do not enter 'Book is Completed' even if the child has finished the book as we still would like to read it in school.



Year 4 - Multiplication Tables Check

- ▶ The purpose of the Multiplication Tables Check is to determine whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently, which is essential for future success in mathematics.
- ▶ The test will consist of more questions from the 6, 7, 8, 9 and 12 times tables, as these are trickier times tables focused on more in Years 3 and 4. (The 2s, 5s and 10s are more of a focus in Years 1 and 2.)



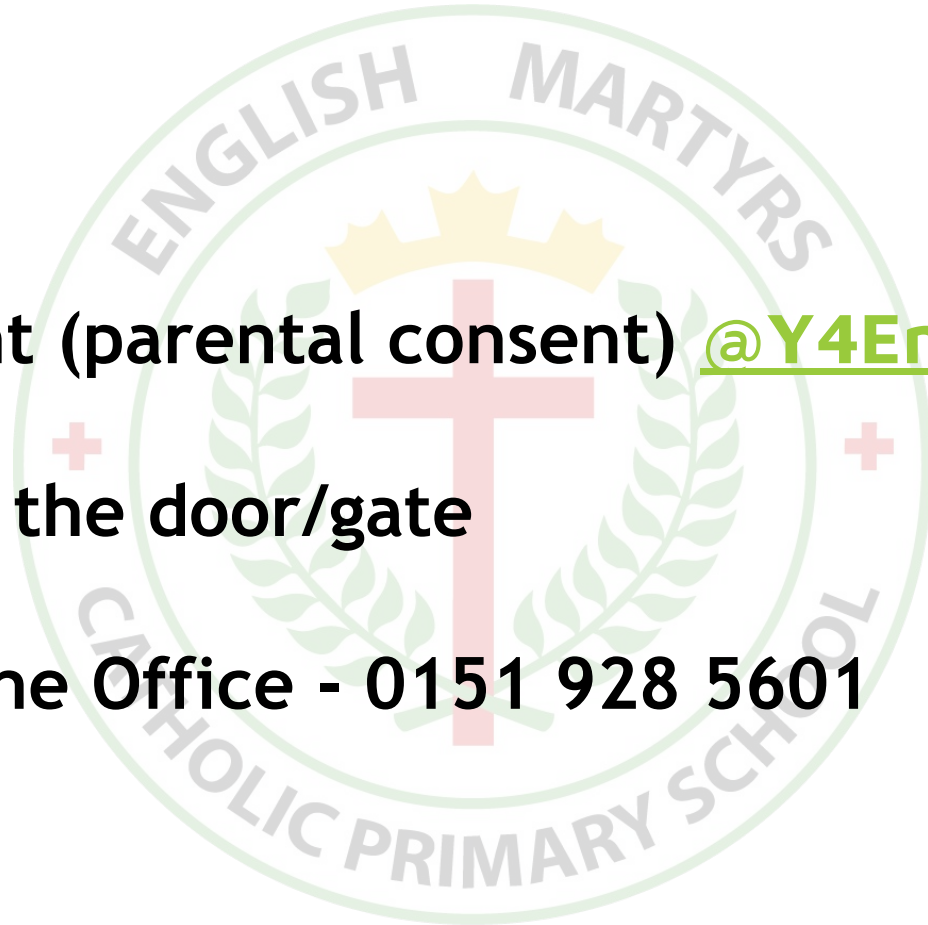
