Children's University

Children's University is a charity that works in partnership with schools to develop a love of learning in children. This is achieved by encouraging and celebrating participation in extra-curricular activities in and outside of school.

- One credit is awarded for one hour of activity (from clubs that are validated by CU) with a maximum of ten credits per term per activity
- Credits from clubs in school are recorded by school (not in passport)
- Half termly activities are sent out to parentsphotos showing evidence of completion of tasks sent to CU and credits are awarded.
- Graduation takes place in Year 2 and Year 6-Graduation Ceremony at Edge Hill.
- Credits can be achieved from residentials, Summer Reading Challenges and visiting particular museums.




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

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Year 4 - Multiplication Tables Check

The purpose of the Multiplication Tables Check is to determine whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently, which is essential for future success in mathematics.

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The test will consist of more questions from the 6, 7, 8, 9 and 12 times tables, as these are trickier times tables focused on more in Years 3 and 4. (The 2s, 5s and 10s are more of a focus in Years 1 and 2.)
