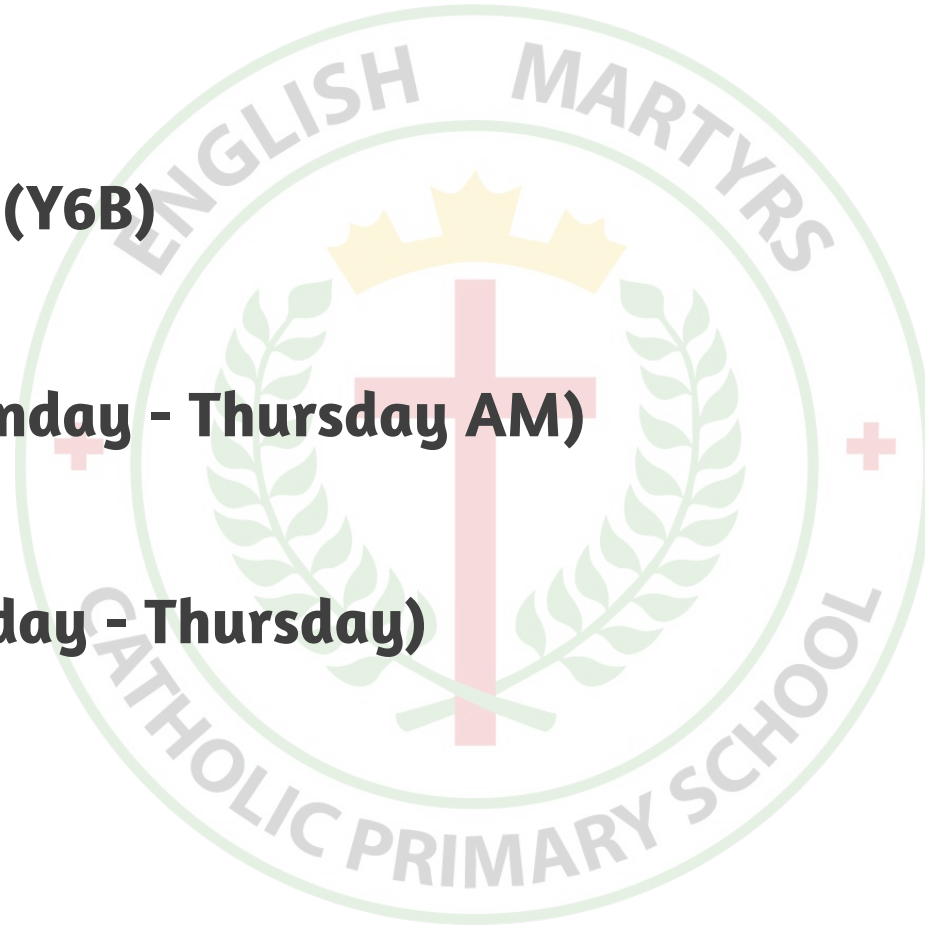

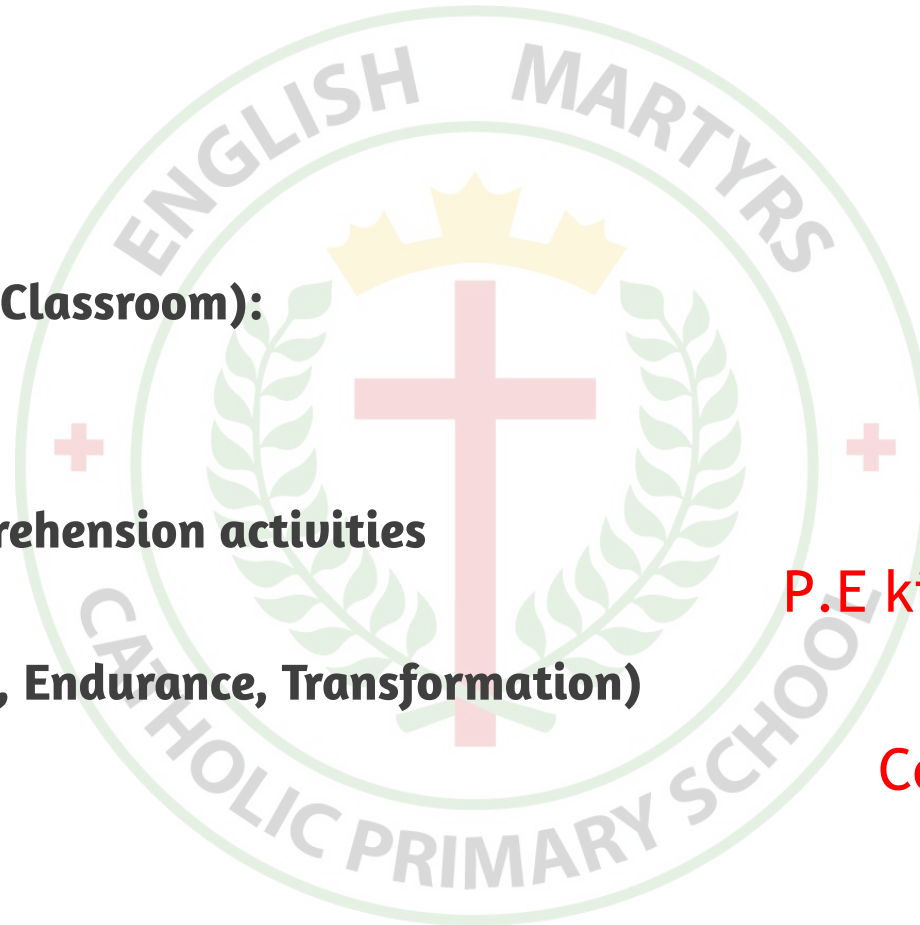

New research shows the different numbers of words kids will have heard by age 5 based on how often parents read to them.

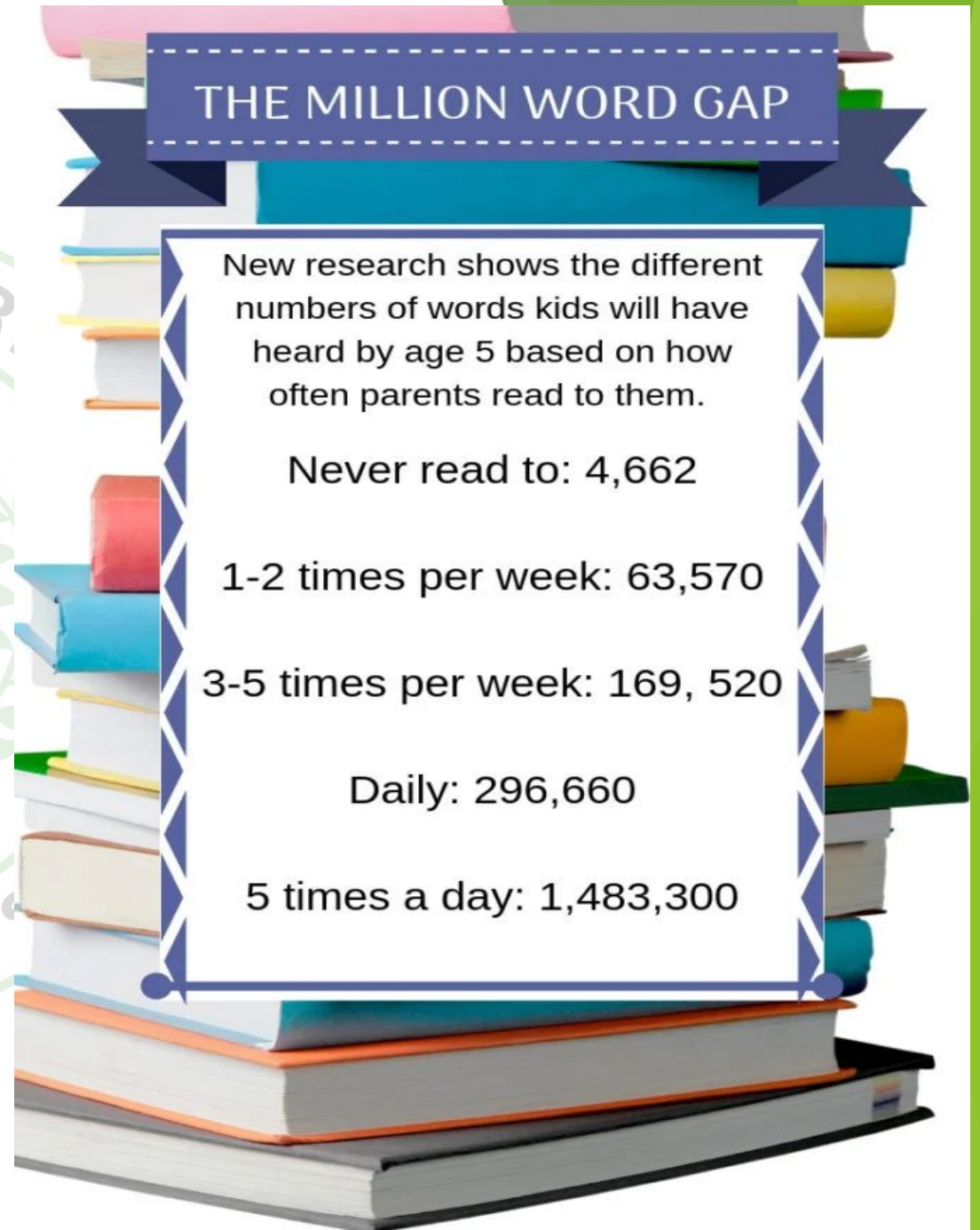
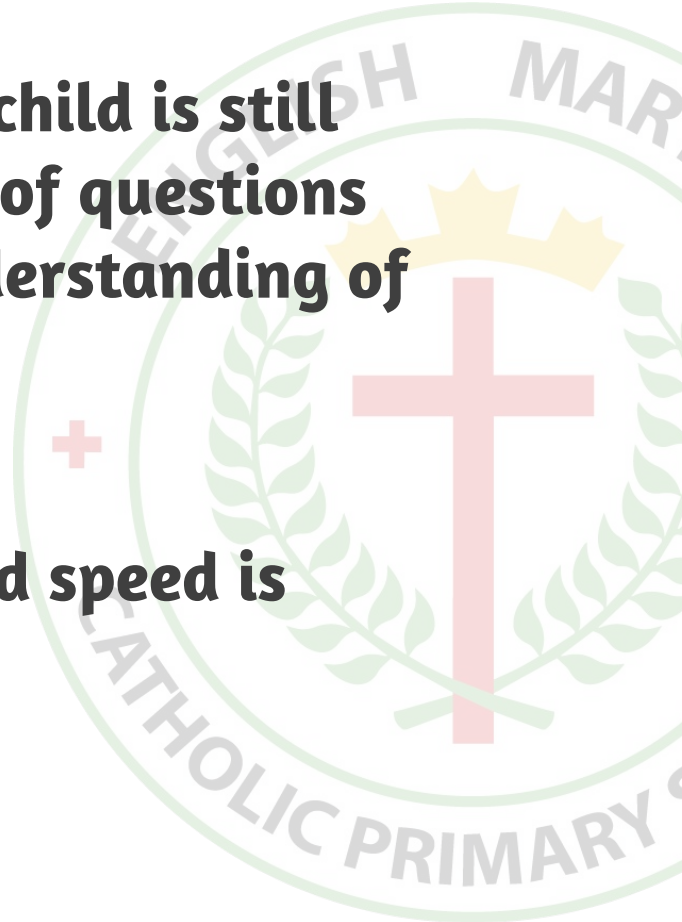

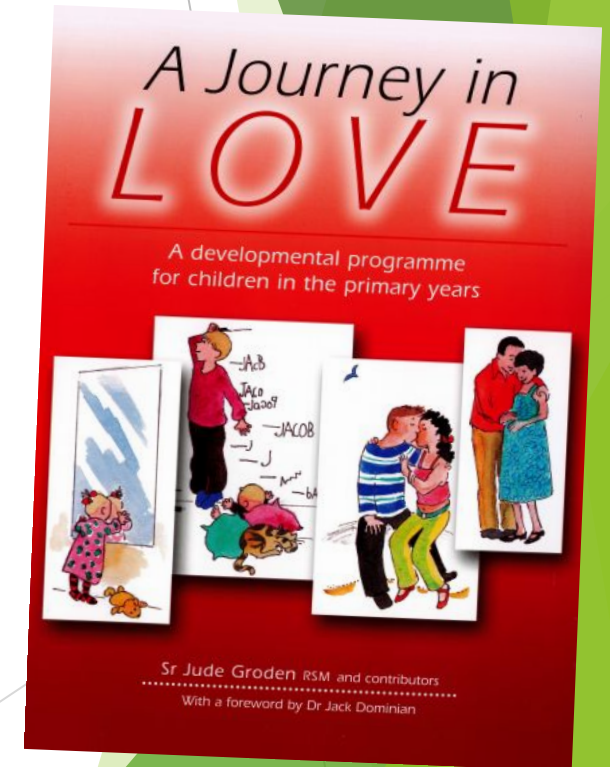
A Journey In Love

Children's University

Children's University is a charity that works in partnership with schools to develop a love of learning in children. This is achieved by encouraging and celebrating participation in extra-curricular activities in and outside of school.

- ▶ Passports available from the office - £3
- ▶ One credit is awarded for one hour of activity (from clubs that are validated by CU) - with a maximum of ten credits per term per activity
- ▶ Credits from clubs in school are recorded by school (not in passport)
- ▶ Half termly activities are sent out to parents- photos showing evidence of completion of tasks sent to CU and credits are awarded
- ▶ Graduation takes place in Year 2 and Year 6- Graduation Ceremony at Edge Hill



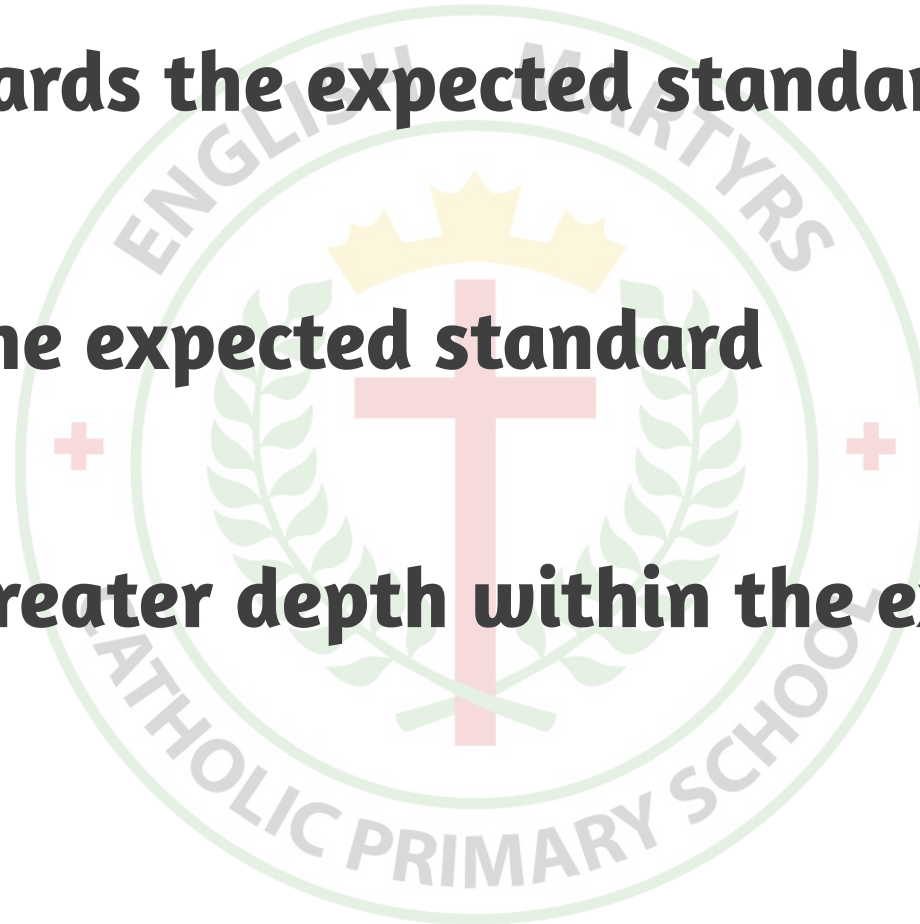
KS2 SATs

2 x 40 min Reasoning Paper**

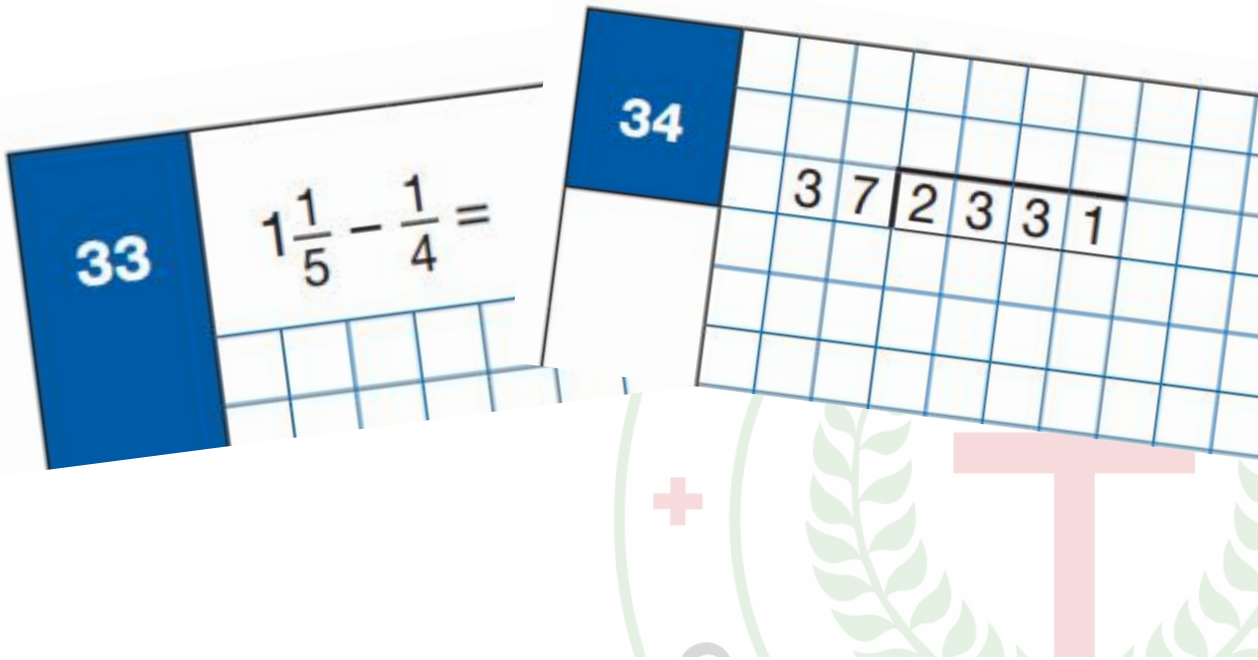
