



# Annual Parent Survey - 2024



## Key Findings:

This survey was responded to by **54** parents, which represents a **26%** return rate (206 families).

**98%** stated that their child is happy at school.

**100%** stated that their child feels safe in school (*when combining Strongly Agree and Agree as well as Don't know hasn't been an issue though*).

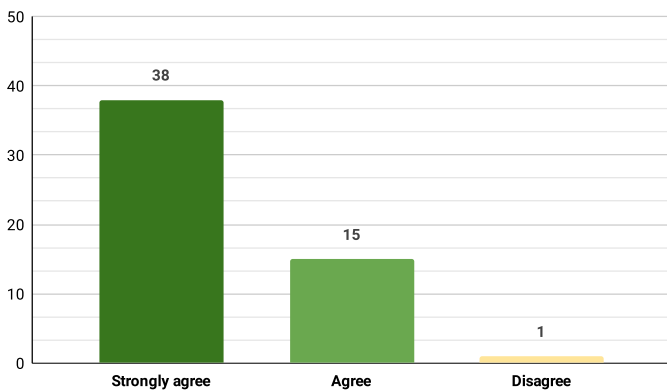
**98%** stated that the school makes sure the pupils are well behaved.

**93%** stated that the school has dealt with bullying quickly (*with 81% stating their child had never experienced bullying*).

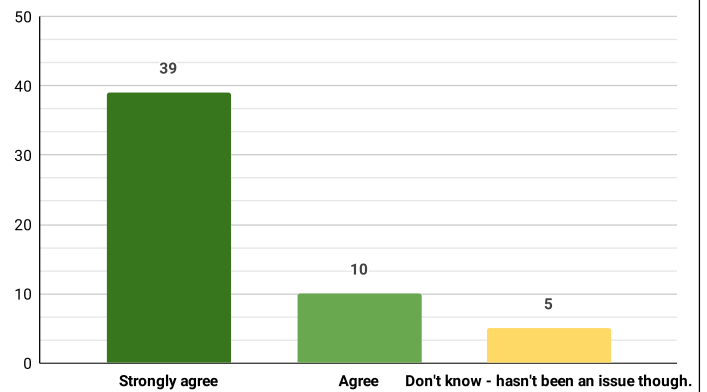
**85%** stated that they are aware of what their child will learn during the year.

**100%** stated that when concerns have been raised they have been dealt with properly.

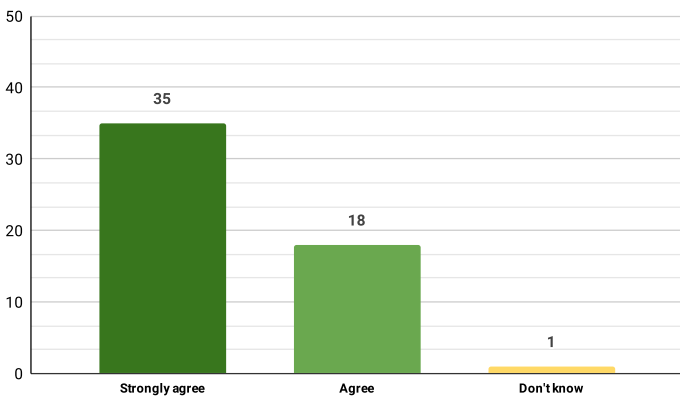
### 1. My child is happy at school.



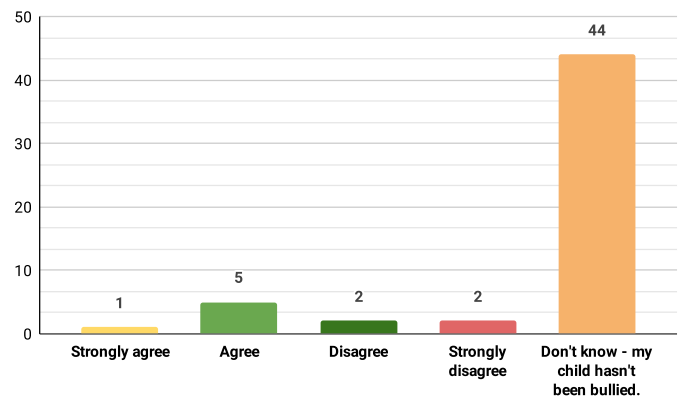
### 2. My child feels safe at school.



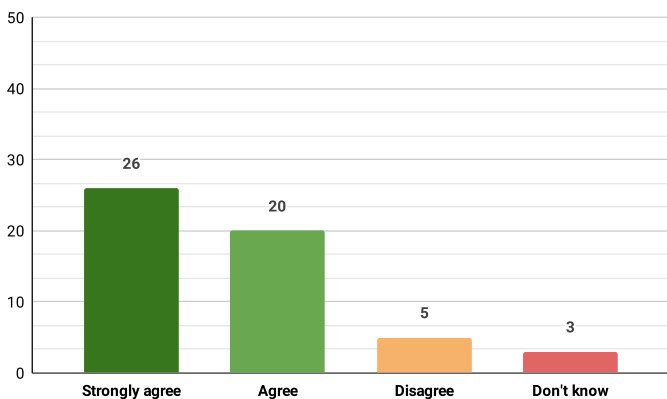
### 3. The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved.



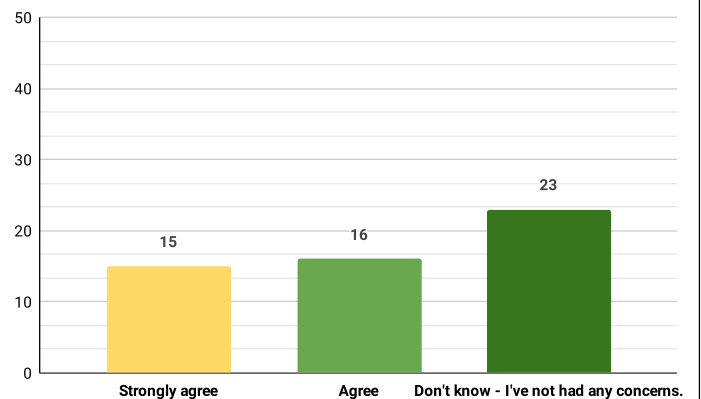
### 4. My child has been bullied and the school dealt with the bullying quickly.

**98%** stated that their child does well at school.

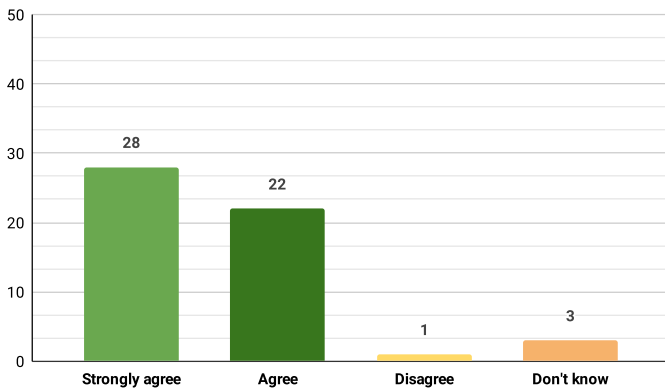
**93%** stated that the school lets them know how their child is doing.

**93%** stated that there is a good range of subjects available for their children.

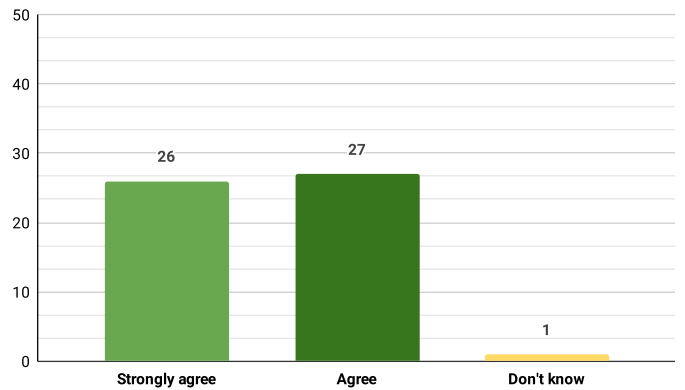
**91%** stated that there are clubs and activities available for their children.

**98%** stated that they would recommend the school to another parent.

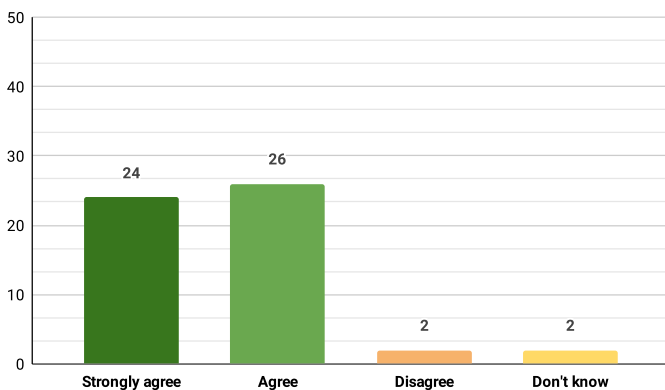
### 7. The school has high expectations for my child.



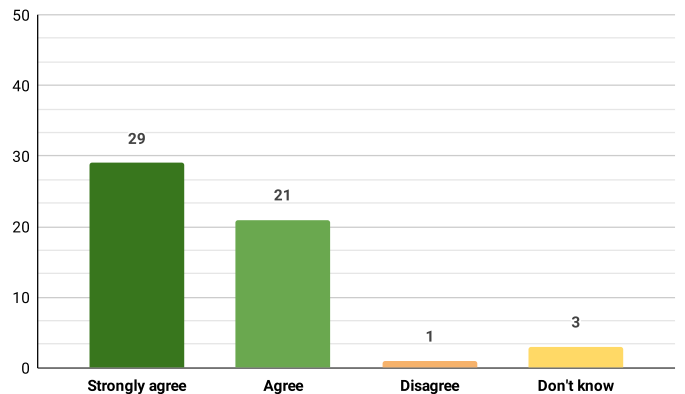
### 8. My child does well at this school.



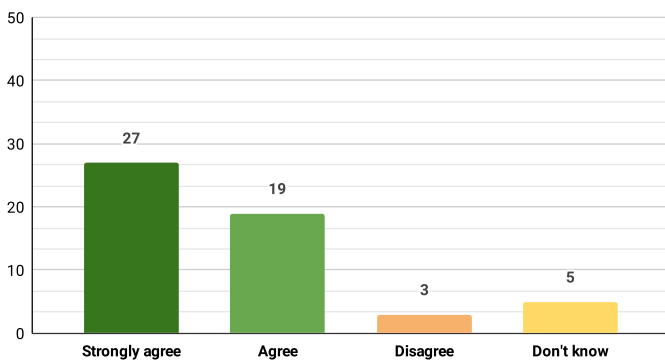
### 9. The school lets me know how my child is doing.



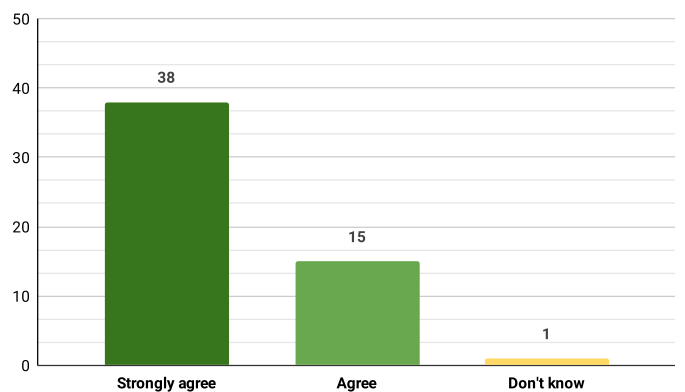
### 10. There is a good range of subjects available to my child at this school.

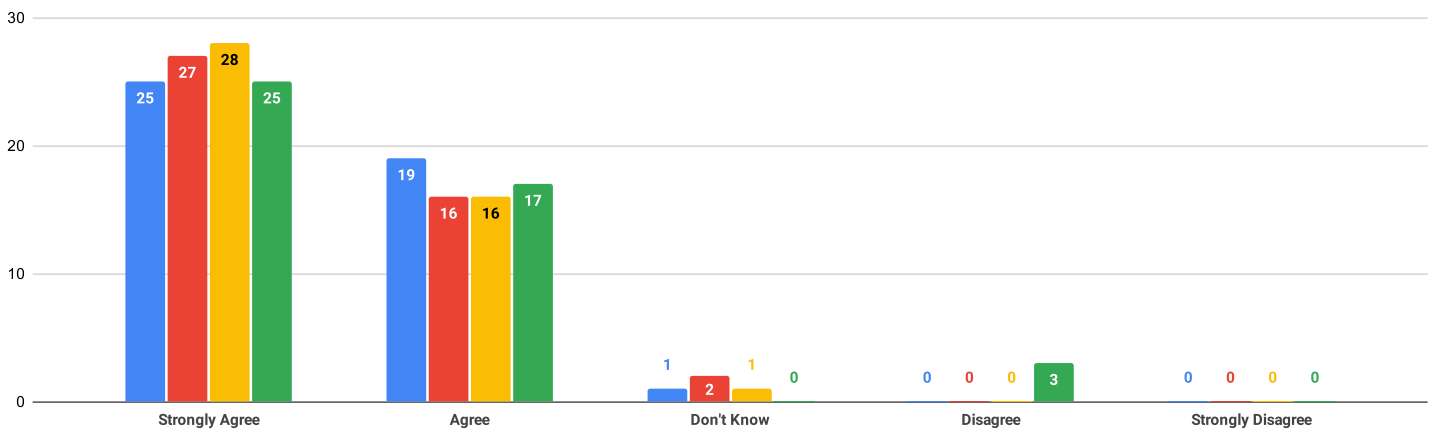


## Key Findings:

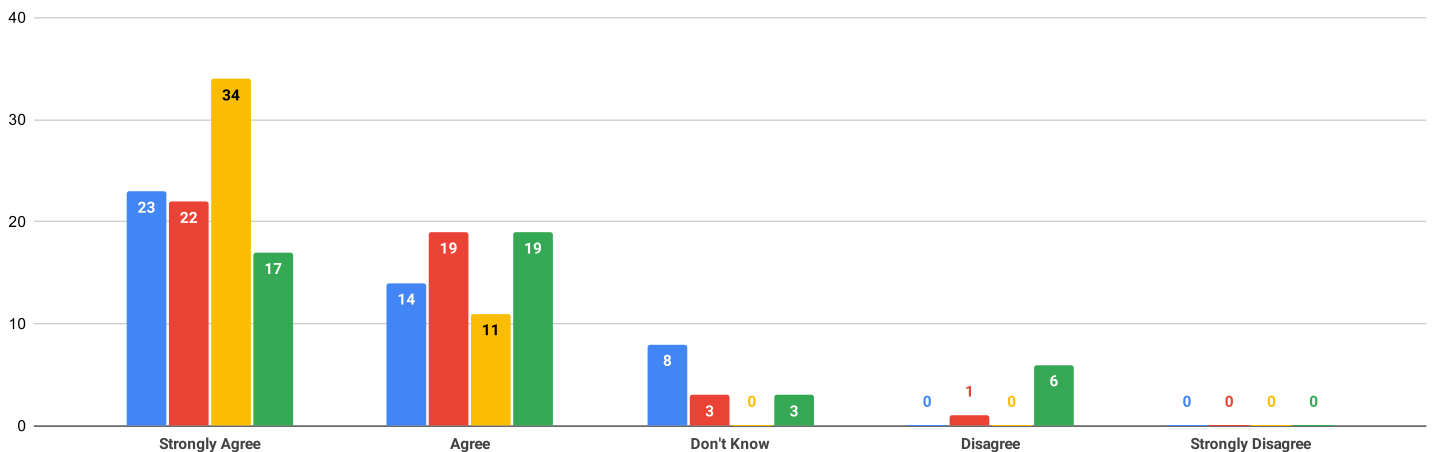


## Key Findings:
