The children will play either drums, bass guitar, lead guitar, keyboard or vocals and they are skilfully taught so that each term they have a assembly “showcase”.

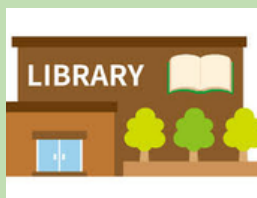
