| YEAR<br>1 | Changes within living memory and connected to aspects of change in national life (Our lives / Toys form the past)   | Events beyond living memory that are significant nationally- The Great fire of London  |
|           | <ul> <li>I can recognise how people grow and change over time and how I have grown and changed over time.</li> <li>I can talk about past experiences in my life.</li> <li>I can recognise that toys from the more distant past (100 years ago) were often wooden and handmade and are different from toys of today.</li> <li>I can identify that some toys have hardly changed over time e.g. teddy bears, Lego.</li> <li>I can recognise and discuss the difference between toys of the past and present.</li> </ul> | <ul> <li>The fire of London started in a bakery in Pudding Lane on 2nd September 1666.</li> <li>The fire burned for 4 days.</li> <li>Lots of homes were destroyed by the fire and many people were left homeless. Many left London to live elsewhere and some slept in tents.</li> <li>Samuel Pepys wrote a diary about events that happened</li> <li>After the fire King Charles II decreed that houses should be made of stone not wood.</li> </ul>  |
| YEAR<br>2 | Significant individuals who have contributed to national/international achievements.  | Significant historical places in their locality  |
|           | <ul> <li>I know why Christopher Columbus and Neil Armstrong are significant individuals.</li> <li>I know that Christopher Columbus was born in Italy.</li> <li>I know Christopher Columbus' ship was named the Santa Maria.</li> <li>I know that CC landed in the Bahamas in 1492 – He called this the New world.</li> <li>I know that Neil Armstrong was born in USA in the state of Ohio.</li> <li>I know that NA was the first man to step on the moon to step in 1969.</li> </ul>                                 | <ul> <li>I know that Chorley was a mill town.</li> <li>I know that Chorley mills often produced cotton and was called by some a 'cotton town.'</li> <li>Holidays of mill workers were often called 'Wakes weeks' People would often travel by train to local coastal towns such as Blackpool/Morecambe during these weeks.</li> <li>In the 1930s cotton production started to decrease.</li> </ul>   |
| YEAR<br>3 | The Roman Empire and its impact on Britain  | Changes in Britain from Stone age to the Iron Age.   |
|           | <ul> <li>I know the Romans successfully invaded Britain in AD43 after three previous failed attempts.</li> <li>I know that Iron Age Britons (such as Boudicca) were against Roman rule and fought back against them.</li> <li>I can discuss how the Roman empire expanded and why. Well organised and well drilled army</li> <li>I can discuss the difference between the poor and rich people in Roman Britain.</li> <li>I know that Romans left Britain in 410AD.</li> </ul>  | <ul> <li>I know that the three ages are classed as prehistory – a time before written records.</li> <li>I know that the Stone Age had 3 periods – Palaeolithic, Mesolithic and Neolithic.</li> <li>I know the order of the ages stone – bronze – iron</li> <li>The Romans invaded Britain which eventually ended the Iron</li> <li>Age in AD 43.</li> <li>I know that Skara Brae is a famous prehistoric village in Scotland, Orkney islands, I can talk about the historic findings of this site.</li> <li>I know Druids were the priests of tribes in the Iron Age.</li> <li>They believed in over 400 gods and made sacrifices to keep the gods happy.</li> </ul> |

| YEAR<br>6 | The achievements of the earliest civilizations — an overview of where and when the first civilizations appeared — Ancient Egypt.  | Year 6 NC Statement – a non-European society that provides contrasts with British history – one study chosen Mayan Civilization.   |
|           | <ul> <li>I know the importance the River Nile had on the development and success of the Egyptian Civilization.</li> <li>I know that the Egyptian civilization was split into different time periods and can talk about significant events within each period. e.g Old, Middle and New, when Ancient Egypt was at its strongest</li> <li>I can name some Egyptian Pharaohs and talk about their significance.</li> <li>I understand the different structures within Egyptian society and can compare them to/make comparisons with other time periods studied.</li> <li>I can explain and reason about different successes of the civilisation and justify which aspects have impacted the most</li> <li>I can discuss the importance of the discovery of Tutankhamun's burial site and what the artefacts uncovered have taught historians about beliefs in the afterlife and life during the civilisation .</li> </ul> | <ul> <li>I know the Maya civilisation spanned a significant time in History over 3000 years. 2000BCE -909CE and that this was broken down into four main eras.</li> <li>I know that the Maya settled in Central America and can give reasons for their settlement using geographical knowledge</li> <li>I know that the Maya had many city states and can name/identify how they were governed and how the city states were constructed Tikal, Uaxactún, Palenque.</li> <li>I know a number of the Mayan Gods and can discuss what the Mayans believed about these gods and make comparisons to other civilisations studied (Egypt/Greece/Britain) for example:         <ul> <li>Itzamna - the creator god</li> <li>Chaac - the rain god</li> <li>Yum Kaax - the nature god</li> <li>Itx Chel - the goddess of medicine and childbirth</li> <li>Kinich Ahau - the sun god</li> </ul> </li> </ul> |
