Christmas is the time when Christians remember the special story of the birth of Jesus. It teaches Christians that God loves them and sent them his only son.

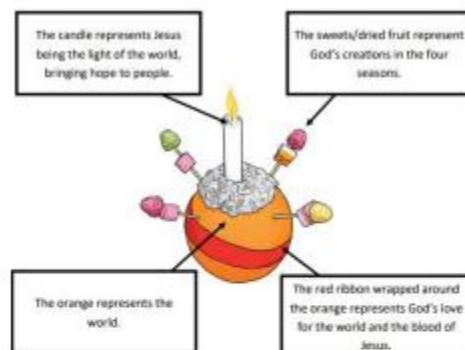


The Advent Wreath in Church has Four White Candles for
