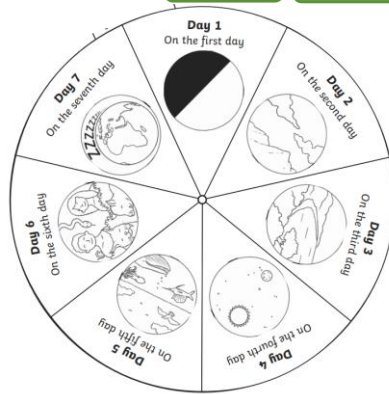
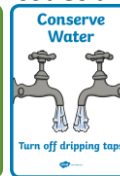
Prior Learning:
