#### **HEADTEACHER MESSAGE:**

As we head into May, we approach the time of year that pupils in Years 1, 2, 4 and 6 undertake summative assessments. At Primrose Hill, we try to keep these assessments as low profile as possible in order to minimise anxiety levels for pupils. As parents however, it is important that you know which assessments are being undertaken and when, and also how the assessments are being implemented. Hopefully, the following information will act as a useful summary:

The information gained from these assessments help us to assess the quality of education on offer at Primrose Hill as well as providing accountability measures for the Department for Education. The outcomes of all assessments will be shared on the end of year reports, which will be sent home in July. Should you have any queries regarding any of the assessments, please speak to your child's class teacher.


