£1 IN A BOX IS BACK! - PAYMENT ITEM NOW ON PARENTPAY

A payment item has been created on ParentPay. It is called '£1 in a box May 25'. Every half term you pay £1 or more on ParentPay. At the end of the half term your payments will be allocated a number (so if you pay £3.00 you will be allocated 3 numbers). 50% of payments received will go to the PTA and the other 50% will be divided 30/20 and two winners will be at the end of term. The amount won depends on how much is paid into '£1 in a box' on ParentPay. The deadline for this term is Monday 9th July and the winners will be announced in the Wednesday Weekly. 

Special Lunch - Thursday 15th May 2025

We are having a 'Dinosaur Day' special lunch on Thursday 15th May 2025, which is open to all children. If your child is on packed lunches and would like this special lunch, please make a payment of £2.95 for the '25 Dinosaur Day SL' payment item within ParentPay www.parentpay.com/by 12 noon, Friday 25th April 2025. Please note: For children in EYFS, KS1 and children who are entitled to a free school lunch who usually bring a packed lunch but would like to have a 'special dinner' instead, you will need to inform the school office by the set deadline above as there is no payment item in ParentPay. If your child is already on a school lunch they will automatically receive this lunch. Unfortunately, no late orders can be accepted.



SIGNIFICANT CHANGES TO PENALTY NOTICE CHARGES

The DfE have recently announced national charges to penalty notices issues for unauthorised absences in term time, these came into into effect on the 19th August 2024.

- Penalty notices issued for the offence after the 19th of August 2024 will be charged at the new rate of £160.00 however if paid in 21-days this reduces to £80.00.
- Any second penalty notice to the same parent for the same child in a rolling 3-year period will be issued at the rate of £160.00 to be paid within 28-days with no option for a discount.
- Penalty notice threshold is 10-sessions equivalent to 5-days of unauthorised absence in a rolling 10-school week period.
- Maximum of 2-penalty notices may be issued for the same child within a rolling 3-years period, so at the 3rd or subsequent offence another course of action will need to be considered such a prosecution or one of the other attendance legal interventions.

Volunteer Qualities

- Must be over 18 years old to volunteer
- Have a positive attitude and a caring nature
- Good communication and interpersonal skills
- Passionate about supporting, enabling and empowering people who are vulnerable, isolated or in need of support
- Have a non-judgemental attitude to working with people of any, gender, family status, sexual identity, ethnic origin, culture, religion or disability.
- You must understand that some of our families are vulnerable, and it would be an advantage if you had an awareness of key issues such as alcohol, drug abuse and mental health; however, this is not a compulsory requirement as training is provided.
- You must always apply the strictest confidence with regard to the sensitivity of those that you are supporting.
- You must be able to provide a clear DBS, if you do not have a current certificate this can be applied for.

Training and on going support for volunteers

Volunteers are thoroughly trained and supported before and during their time supporting families. You can expect:

- Self-directed and instructor-led induction program training, that is delivered both online and in person.
- Ongoing training in specific areas including trauma-informed practice, domestic violence, abuse, and attachment theory.
- Annual refresher training to ensure you are up to date with all statutory requirements
- Regular support and supervision sessions with an experienced family support coordinator
- Paid expenses when you complete your training and are actively supporting a family within their home

HAF is for children and young people who are:

- In reception class to year 11.
- Entitled to benefits related Free School Meals
- Not on FSM but who but have another kind of vulnerability, ask school about this.
- At Easter you will be able to book 4 days (minimum of 4 hours) of activities and they will get a meal included.

Holiday Activities and Food Vouchers

- There is no application process, vouchers are automatically sent to parents if their child is eligible
- Schools order vouchers for all their FSM pupils they don't send them.
- Schools identify and order the vouchers for children with other vulnerabilities
- Other professionals working with families can order vouchers









- Vouchers are sent to parents by email and text from Hello@holidayactivities.com
- If you have not received a voucher and believe you should have, please ask at your child's school.
- The vouchers have a link to the booking system.
- The vouchers are linked to the district your child attends school in – if you live in another district -contact
 CFW-HAF@lancashire.gov.uk and this can be transferred
- If you transferred a voucher in the previous holiday period, the transfer will stay in place and vouchers will be issued in that districts for the next holiday.
