UNIFORM:

It has been fantastic to see the pupils looking so smart upon their return to school this week. The standards of uniform have been excellent, especially Year 3 pupils who have impressively mastered tying their new ties!

Just a couple of reminders:

- We operate a no jewellery policy at Primrose Hill, except for basic watches. Pupils with newly pierced ears can wear the spacer earing (clear plastic studs) during September but all earrings must be removed from the start of October.
- Designs shaven into hair are not allowed, and any hair longer than shoulder length must be tied back with a discreet headband or bobble. Please avoid repeating any shaven designs done over the summer during term time.

Thank you for your understanding and support in maintaining high uniform standards.

TRAFFIC AND PARKING:

We would like to remind parents and carers about the unofficial one-way system outside school. As you may know, Primrose Hill Road can get very busy at drop-off and pick-up times. To help ease congestion, please follow the one-way system, passing the school on your left-hand side. This allows for several exit routes from the estate and helps traffic flow more smoothly. Please remember that the staff car parks are always out of bounds to parents and carers, including those using the Out of

School Club. The only exception is for blue badge holders, who may use the disabled bays at the front of the school and should contact school prior to parking.

Finally, and most importantly, please be respectful of others, including local residents, when parking your vehicle near the school. Ensure there is enough room for prams and wheelchair users on the paths, space for emergency vehicles to pass, and that you do not obstruct residents' driveways. Residents may need access to their properties during drop-off and collection times, so please leave sufficient space. Thank you for your support in this matter.

SIGNIFICANT CHANGES TO PENALTY NOTICE CHARGES

The DfE have recently announced national charges to penalty notices issues for unauthorised absences in term time, these came into into effect on the 19th August 2024.

- Penalty notices issued for the offence after the 19th of August 2024 will be charged at the new rate of £160.00 however if paid in 21-days this reduces to £80.00.
- Any second penalty notice to the same parent for the same child in a rolling 3-year period will be issued at the rate of £160.00 to be paid within 28-days with no option for a discount.
- Penalty notice threshold is 10-sessions equivalent to 5-days of unauthorised absence in a rolling 10-school week period.
- Maximum of 2-penalty notices may be issued for the same child within a rolling 3-years period, so at the 3rd or subsequent offence another course of action will need to be considered such a prosecution or one of the other attendance legal interventions.

MEDICATION IN SCHOOL

If your child requires any prescribed medication during school hours, please inform the school office as soon as possible. As a rule, we are not able to administer medication to pupils, however we will always try to work with you to ensure the wellbeing of your child. We do store essential medications according to children's specific medical needs in school (for example: Epi-pens; inhalers, eczema creams etc.). Please **DO NOT** send any medication in with your child. This can be dangerous to other children. It must be handed in at the school office, by an adult, to an adult along with a completed medication form.

There is still lots of medication held in the school office from last term. Please could you check your emails via ParentMail to see if you need to collect your child's medication. All medication that need needs to be kept in school will require a new form completing before any medication can be administered.








Pupil Achievements and Celebrations
