SIGNIFICANT CHANGES TO PENALTY NOTICE CHARGES

The DfE have recently announced national charges to penalty notices issues for unauthorised absences in term time, these came into into effect on the 19th August 2024.

- Penalty notices issued for the offence after the 19th of August 2024 will be charged at the new rate of £160.00 however if paid in 21-days this reduces to £80.00.
- Any second penalty notice to the same parent for the same child in a rolling 3-year period will be issued at the rate of £160.00 to be paid within 28-days with no option for a discount.
- Penalty notice threshold is 10-sessions equivalent to 5-days of unauthorised absence in a rolling 10-school week period.
- · Maximum of 2-penalty notices may be issued for the same child within a rolling 3-years period, so at the 3rd or subsequent offence another course of action will need to be considered such a prosecution or one of the other attendance legal interventions.

Dear Parent / Carer, Event: Obstacle and Colour Run

Date: 16th July 2025 Location: School Field

We are thrilled to announce that we will be hosting an **Obstacle Run** to celebrate the end of the school year! This exciting event is being organised in collaboration with **Chorley Schools Sport Partnership** and promises to be a fun and memorable experience for all involved.

This is an optional event and it will take place on the school field during the school day. If you would like your child to take part the cost will be £2.10 per child and there is a payment item on ParentPay. The deadline for payment is 3pm on Tuesday 15th July. Pupils who have paid will attend a **mandatory pre-race safety briefing**. Please note that attendance at the briefing is compulsory for all participants.

To ensure your child is prepared for the event, we kindly ask that they come to school wearing **old but practical sports shoes** and **comfortable clothing.** (Shorts or leggings and a t-shirt, preferably white or light-coloured to highlight the colours) **Please** be aware that clothing may become stained or damaged during the event so it is advised to bring a change of clothes and a towel.

For safety reasons, all students are required to wear **sunglasses** during the run. If your child does not have a pair, we will have some available on the day, however these will be limited. While the event is designed to be safe and enjoyable, we do want to highlight that participation involves some level of risk. However, a **comprehensive risk assessment** has been carried out by the Chorley Schools Sport Partnership, and the event will be fully supervised. The foam and colour powders used are biodegradable, **hypoallergenic and non-toxic**. They are safe for skin and clothing and pose no harm to wildlife or the environment.

Colour should wash off hair and body immediately (highlighted hair may take 2 washes). The colour does come out of clothes but it is recommended to wash separately.

If your child has any **medical conditions** that may affect their ability to participate, please inform the school directly.

We look forward to your child's participation in what promises to be a joyful celebration to end the school year!
