#### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

#### **One Way System**

Just a reminder that the one-way system involves travelling down Primrose Hill Road, passing school on your left hand side and exiting left or right via Cedar Avenue and operates between the hours of 8.25am – 9.00am and 2.40pm – 3.10pm.
