## Key Learning – Our School Environment

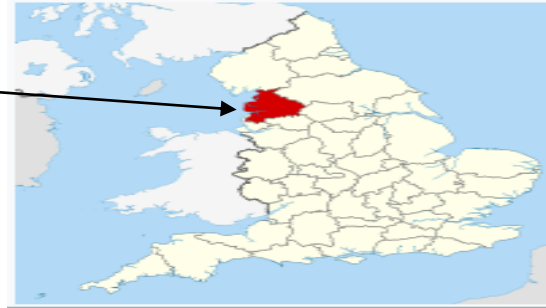
- Our school is in Euxton.

## Key Vocabulary

<b>Aerial view</b>	A view from above
<b>House</b>	A building for humans to live in
<b>Human Geography</b>	Features of land that have been impacted by human activity.
<b>Map</b>	A drawing of a particular area such as a city, a country or continent.
<b>Park</b>	A large public garden or area of land used by the public.
<b>Physical Geography</b>	Natural features of land.
<b>Town</b>	A large group of houses, shops and buildings where people live and work.
<b>Village.</b>	A small group of houses with a small amount of shops. Villages are often found in the country side.
