Making Skills (Techniques)

Printing

Make simple marks on rollers and printing palettes.
Take simple prints i.e. mono -printing.
Roll printing ink over found objects to create patterns e.g. plastic mesh, stencils.
Build repeating patterns and recognise pattern in the environment.

Cyanotype Prints

Cyanotypes, a slow reacting, photographic printing method using light reactive papers. Creates images of white against blue backgrounds.

Focus Artist :

Anna Atkins English botanist and photographer. She is often considered the first person to publish a book illustrated with photographic images.
