Vocabulary

Design – Thinking about what you want to make before starting a project.

Materials – Fabrics all have different properties eg felt is soft, cotton is cool.

Template – a rigid piece of material used as a pattern to assist when cutting out material.

Joining – A way of making two pieces of fabric stick together (glue, staples, sewing)

Sewing – using a needle to join two pieces of fabric together.

Stitch – moving the cotton thread between the fabric to hold it together.

Evaluation – to say how successful the final product is.


