## Key Learning

- The Amazon Rainforest is a region within Brazil.
- Tropical rainforests are dominated by broad leaved ever-green trees which form a continuous canopy in areas of high rainfall.
- The Forest of Bowland is a region in Lancashire.
  - Temperate woodland are dominated by broad-leaved and needle-leaved deciduous trees.
- A tropical climate is found between the Topics of Cancer and Capricorn and characterized by average temperatures above 18°C and feature hot temperatures all year round. Rainfall is high.
  - A temperate climate is characterized by moderate rainfall spread across the year with sporadic drought, mild to warm summers and cool to cold winters.
- Human deforestation is having a devastating impact on the Amazon Rainforest – less rain, forest fires, Loss of habitat.
- Forest of Bowland is a managed woodland and timber is a cash crop.
