The word 'oligarchy' comes from the greek root words 'oligos' (meaning 'few') and 'arkhein' (meaning 'rule').

# **Athens**

A council of 500 citizens was randomly picked each year.

They made new laws which were then voted on by the assembly - which comprised of the remaining Athenian citizens.

- Women stay home
- Liked to trade
- Democracy
- Education military, arts, literature & philosophy



Two Kings ruled the city-state, but a council of elders limited their powers. The elders were men from the highest social class in ancient Greece.

- Education- military training for boys
- Strong military
- Women basic military training
- Women had rights
- Oligarchy
