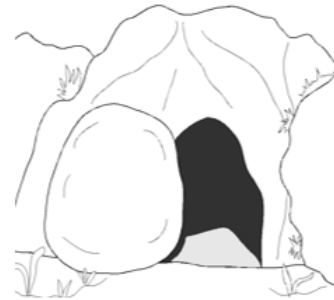
Key Vocabulary

Divine	Of or like God or a god.
Incarnate	Embodiment/represent in human form.
Pilgrimage	Journey to a sacred place.
resurrection	Rising from the dead.
Crucifixion	Put to death on the cross.

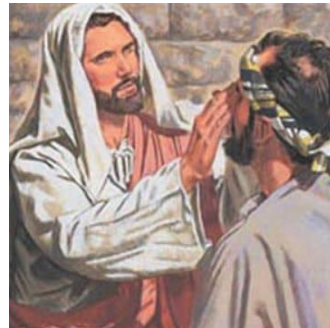
