## Holy Book - The Quran

Muslims believe the Quran is the word of Allah (God), which was revealed to the prophet Muhammad (pbuh) by the angel Gabriel.



# The Prophet Muhammad (pbuh)

- Muhammad (pbuh) was born in in 570ad in Mecca, Saudi Arabia.
- Muslims believe Muhammad (pbuh) was the final prophet sent by Allah.
- When he was 40, Muslims believe that Allah told Muhammad (pbuh) the Quran, even though he could not read or write. They believe it is entirely Allah's words.
- Prophet Muhammad is so special to Muslims that they say peace be upon him after his name every time they say or write it. Also, no one may create an image of him to show their respect.

# The Five Pillars of Islam. These are the five most important duties for Muslims. The Shahadah The belief that there is no God but Allah and that Muhammad is his messenger. Praying five times a day. Attending the pilgrimage to Makkah once in your lifetime.

Muslims can donate The money goes towards emergency help, building communities, education and healthcare.

Muslim Aid was started to help poor people in Africa, but now the charity works in 8 different countries worldwide.
