Achievements at Evergreen PRU

When Evergreen welcomes a new pupil, we complete a baseline assessment for Reading, English skills and Maths. We use this to introduce targeted interventions with Mrs Parker, and ensure that work is appropriate and achievable within the classroom. Each term we assess whether the children's hard work has had a positive impact. Evergreen are extremely pleased to share that nearly 50% of our pupils are working at expected or exceeding in Reading and English.
