



Jack Petchey Achievement Award

Almost 2,000 schools, colleges and youth organisations throughout London and Essex run the scheme, which contributes millions of pounds each year. The scheme is a reward and recognition initiative which enables schools and youth organisations to celebrate the achievements of their young people as well as receive additional funding.

How does the scheme work?

- 1. The school regularly select a young person to receive an Achievement Award – Evolve Academy selects 4 Students, one a month from February - May
- 2. The nomination and selection processes are led by the young people within our school.
- 3. When a winner is selected they are publicly congratulated for their achievement and receive:
 - A framed certificate and badge
 - Membership of the JPF Achievers community
 - £250 to be spent on a something of their choice that will benefit our school (for example, a piece of equipment, a day out for the team, a specialist trainer to come in give a session).
- 4. Award winners are further recognised by attending one of the Jack Petchey celebration events where they are congratulated on stage in front of friends and family.
- 5. In order to make this run smoothly, we have 'coordinator' who is responsible for the internal management and overseeing of the scheme in the school.
