Entry Level 3 -Level 2 Award in Personal Development & Employability Skills - 6 Credits

Entry Level 3-Level 2 Certificate in Personal Development & Employability Skills – 21 Credits Entry Level 3-Level 2 or Diploma in Personal Development & Employability Skills – 38 Credits

Award, Certificate or Diploma at EL3, level 1 or level 2 in subjects such as, **Career Planning** (which involves, career research, cv making, mock interviews etc).

Managing Money (which involves learning how to open a bank account and how to understand the various services banks offer and learn the best methods to budget your finances.

Digital Skills (which involve Internet safety and ways to avoid online negative behaviour as well as creating presentations using IT tools).
