



Pupil Premium at Fairfield Primary School 2015/2016

The government believes that effective use of Pupil Premium funding, which is additional to the main school funding, is the best way to address the current underlying inequalities between children, ensuring that funding to tackle disadvantage reaches the pupils who need it most.

Schools decide how Pupil Premium funding is spent, since they are best placed to assess what additional provision needs to be made for those individual children eligible for the funding.

Since September 2012 schools have been required to publish online information as to how pupil premium has been used.

In 2015-2016 the Pupil Premium allocation to our school is £28,320. Our plans for the allocation is outlined below- please note these are indicative figures only and may vary as the year proceeds or allocations are utilised.

Activity	Estimated Costs
Nurture group provision, including staffing costs and resources.	£8,500
Intervention sessions	£12,540
Wraparound day care	£2,500
Enabling eligible pupils to access out of school activities	£2,000
In school counselling service	£2,030
Enabling eligible pupils to access the creative arts (music and singing lessons)	£750
Total	£ 28,320
