

2022 EYFS Results: Headline Figures



Fairfield Primary School

The Department for Education explains that the "good level of development" measure is a performance measure for Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) pupils. Children are considered to have reached a good level of development at the end of the EYFS if they have achieved at least the expected level in:

- the early "learning goals" in the prime areas of learning (personal, social and emotional development, physical development, and communication and language)
- the early learning goals in the specific areas of Mathematics and Literacy.

The GLD measure is supported by a measure of the average of the cohort's total point score across all the 17 early learning goals. The levels attained by children at the end of the EYFS are allocated a number as follows: Emerging = 1, Expected = 2 and Exceeding = 3. For each of the 17 learning goals a child is recorded as having achieved 1, 2 or 3 and therefore it is possible to give children an overall score.

90% of Fairfield pupils achieved GLD in 2022
