

2022 KS1 Assessment Results: Headline Figures



Fairfield Primary School

Following the introduction of the revised, more challenging Primary Curriculum in 2014, the 2022 Key Stage 1 results presented in this document reflect a move away from reporting levels. Instead, pupils now receive test results as a scaled score and teacher assessments based on the interim framework. The headline figures for our school are as follows:

93% of Year 1 Fairfield pupils reached the the pass mark or above in the Phonics Screening Check

80% of Fairfield pupils of KS1 Pupils reached the 'expected standard' in Reading, Writing AND Maths

54% of pupils nationally reached the 'expected standard' in Reading, Writing AND Maths

Scaled Scores

Children receive a scaled score for each Key Stage 1 test. The scaled scores range from 80 – 120 with 100 being the 'Expected Standard'. Children at Fairfield consistently achieved scaled scores that are significantly higher in all subjects compared to the Cumbrian average and the national average.
