



2022 KS2 Assessment Results: Headline Figures

Fairfield Primary School



Following the introduction of the revised, more challenging Primary Curriculum in 2014, the 2022 Key Stage 2 results presented in this document reflect a move away from reporting levels. Instead, pupils now receive test results as a scaled score and teacher assessments based on the interim framework. The headline figures for our school are as follows (they include the new, statutory MTC assessment in Year 4):

70% of Fairfield pupils reached the 'expected standard' in Reading, Writing AND Maths

60% of pupils nationally reached the 'expected standard' in Reading, Writing AND Maths

21 was the average score (out of 25) by **Fairfield pupils** on the Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check (MTC)

Scaled Scores

Children receive a scaled score for each Key Stage 2 test. The scaled scores range from 80 – 120 with 100 being the 'Expected Standard'.

Children at Fairfield achieved scaled scores in all 3 subjects, which were generally in-line with the Cumbrian average and the national average.
