Coronavirus (COVID-19) - UPDATE

Dear Parent/Carer,

The physical health and wellbeing of our school community is our priority. We are continually monitoring the situation both locally and nationally and will act swiftly on any advice/instruction given by central government. Having given careful consideration to the current situation, there are a number of appropriate and proportionate measures we can put in place to help protect ourselves at this time.

Measures we will put in place with effect of Friday 13th March 2020:

- Extend the time children are allocated for handwashing, particularly on arrival at school, after breaks and before lunch to ensure they all thoroughly follow the procedure we have discussed with them. We will also continue to remind children daily about personal hygiene.
- We will assess all trips and visits on an individual basis by looking at all of the factors involved. Plans may have to change at short notice in some cases.
- Reduce the amount of large gatherings of students in indoor spaces (e.g. assembly).
- Reduce the amount of visitors to the school. This includes postponing our Parent & Toddler session on Tuesday mornings.
- Hand sanitizing will be made available to all staff and visitors in the reception areas of the school. We will also ensure that visitors are aware of the public health situation.

Parents' Evening – 16th & 17th March

• We plan to hold the Parents' Evenings as scheduled but would like to offer parents the option of a telephone appointment as an alternative. We will send home reports on Friday to give you an oversight of their progress and attainment. Following this you can either attend as planned, cancel or request a telephone appointment.

Bassenfell Parent Meeting – 12th March

• This will still take place – Please enter via the main KS2 Reception and use the hand sanitizer on your way in.

We will continue to monitor the situation very closely and will follow any advice from Public Health England and the Department for Education. Information can be found at the website shown below:
